

DRESS CODE/UNIFORM POLICY (Grades K5-12) As a private Catholic school, St. Mary's Springs Academy reserves the right to determine appropriate attire and insists upon a norm of proper appearance for its students, faculty and staff. SMSA promotes respect for and the dignity of each individual person, and believes that values are reflected in one's words and behaviors, including grooming and clothing. The school expects students to represent themselves well at school, on field trips and at competitions and other school functions through appropriate attire and proper hygiene. Cleanliness, neatness, safety and modesty are key in determining proper grooming and attire.

Students are expected to dress appropriately for a Catholic school environment. Any clothing that interferes with or disrupts the educational environment is unacceptable. Clothing should fit properly, be neat, clean and conform to standards of safety, good taste and decency.

Parents/guardians have the responsibility of ensuring that their student(s) reports to school appropriately dressed, clean and neat in appearance.

To review approved school uniform selections, go to the Lands' End website by visiting the SMSA web site home page (www.smsacademy.org), click the Family link and select Uniforms. There is a direct link to the uniform store at Lands' End on that page. Once on the Lands' End page, create an account for your student(s) to help with the ordering process. Any item available to order on the SMSA dedicated Lands' End website is dress code approved. Extended sizing options are available. Uniforms are optional for half-day P3 and K4 students. Grades P3-2 are not required to wear Mass Day attire for prayer services. 27 (Revised 9/5/17)

Boys – Grades K5-12 Daily Attire

- Polos and oxfords are the acceptable shirts without the fleece, sweater or cardigan. Oxford shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- Polos, oxfords, sweaters, fleece (must be zipped to collar bone), blazers, dress pants, etc. included on the Lands' End website are approved items for the dress code
- Lands' End logo pants and shorts are recommended but not required. Pant/short color options include: navy, khaki, gray or black.
- Shorts will be allowed April 1 to October 31.
- "Challenge Day" logo wear are approved items for daily wear, but not appropriate for Mass attire. Mass/Special Event Attire (required for grades 6-12)
- Oxford button down shirt in blue, French blue, Lake blue stripe and white with SMSA logo
- Approved SMSA Lands' End striped tie OR bow tie **Bow ties are not available on the Lands' End website; they may be purchased at Scrip office.
- Navy Lands' End blazer with SMSA logo is optional.
- Dress shoes are required.
- Shorts not acceptable on Mass/Special Event Days.

Girls – Grades K5-12 Daily Attire

- Polos and oxfords are the acceptable shirts without the fleece, sweater or cardigan. Boy cut oxfords worn by girls, must be tucked in.
- Polos, oxfords, sweaters, fleece (must be zipped to collar bone), blazers, dress pants, skirts/skorts, jumpers, etc. included on the Lands' End website are approved items for the dress code.
- Lands' End logo pants and shorts are recommended but not required. The color options include: navy, khaki, gray or black.
- Skirts (K5-12), skorts (K5-5), jumpers (K5-5) and polo dresses (K5-5) in classic navy, khaki and classic navy plaid with SMSA logo are required and available on the Lands End website.
- Hosiery for girls is recommended, but optional. Tights, nylons, and ankle length leggings in black, navy, white, or nude are acceptable
- Knee-high socks are acceptable as long as they are in uniform colors 28 (Revised 9/5/17)
- Shorts and capris will be allowed April 1 to October 31.
- "Challenge Day" logo wear are approved items for daily wear, but not appropriate for Mass attire.

Mass/Special Event Attire (required for grades 6-12)

- Oxford button down shirt (full or $\frac{3}{4}$ sleeve) in blue, French blue, and white with SMSA logo.
- Navy Lands' End blazer with SMSA logo is optional.
- Dress shoes are required.
- Shorts are not acceptable on Mass/Special Event Days. Shoes and Foot Apparel:
- Shoes, sandals or boots (not military-style) must be worn in the school building.
- Casual footwear, including but not limited to flip-flops, slides, Crocs and slippers are not allowed.
- Dress shoes are required for Mass Day/Special Event days (grades 6-12)
- Socks, in uniform colors, are recommended.

General Dress guidelines K5 – 12

While it is impossible to list all types of unacceptable attire, limits are placed on clothing that is distracting, inappropriate or indecent. Following are guiding principles regarding appropriate dress:

- Students are expected to be in "dress code" from the time they enter the building until the time that they depart at the end of the day, as well as on any school sanctioned off-campus activity. This includes breaks, lunch, all-school masses, and field trips.

- Non-Lands' End pants must be in the chino style (no cargo, carpenter or jean) in classic navy, black, gray or khaki.
- Skirts, dresses, or shorts that are excessively short and/or excessively tight fitting are not allowed. Skirts/shorts must be mid-thigh or fingertip length with arms at side.
- Boys and girls must wear a solid colored black, brown, navy or white belt if belt loops on pants or shorts are provided
- Students are expected to wear Mass Day attire for school photographs
- Students will be required to dress in uniform attire on competition and performance days. The SMSA Administration Team will notify students of spirit days or jeans days ahead of time
- Long sleeved white shirts may be worn underneath long sleeved polos, but not underneath short sleeved polos
- Any visible undershirts must be solid and in uniform colors (i.e. white, blue, navy blue, French blue, gray, cobalt or black) without any writing or graphics. 29 (Revised 9/5/17)
- Clothing or accessories intended for outdoor use (e.g. hats, caps, bandannas, sunglasses, coats, etc.) may not be worn indoors.
- Clothing that is torn, has holes or is designed to look frayed, or is unkempt or disheveled is not allowed.
- Shirts or blouses that expose midriffs, or have low-cut necklines that expose cleavage are not allowed.
- Low-cut pants or oversized pants that droop or sag, so as to expose underwear, are not allowed.
- Clothing or accessories with language or images that are vulgar, discriminatory, defamatory or obscene is not allowed; clothing or accessories that promote illegal or violent behavior, including but not limited to, the use of weapons, drugs, drug paraphernalia, alcohol or tobacco, is also not allowed.
- Pajamas are not allowed nor are sport/sweat/running/wind pants or shorts (except on designated days).
- Visible tattoos and body piercings (except ears) are not allowed. Ear gauges are not allowed.
- Chains/spiked accessories are not allowed.
- Accessory scarves for boys or girls are not allowed
