The program’s goal is to spark an interest in computer sciences at an early age amongst a gender widely underrepresented in today’s rapidly growing science and technology workforce. Utilizing the programmable “Dash and Dot” robots, this fun learning experience is focused on 21<sup>st</sup> century skills such as technology literacy, creativity, critical thinking and collaboration.
