(Catechists, athletic team coaches, Girl Scout leaders, chaperones for overnight activities, and other Church volunteers who have regular contact with children or youth)

- Must read and sign the [Code of Ethical Standards](#) and the [Mandatory Reporting Statement](#). (A copy of the signed Code will be kept on file at parish or school).
- Will have a criminal background check completed.
- All volunteers who have regular contact with children are required to attend a Safe Environment "Protecting God's Children" awareness session. Please visit, [pre-register for the session](#) to register before the event.
- **Important Notice:** All participants must arrive on time and stay for the entire session. Latecomers will not be admitted and those who leave early will not receive credit for attendance.

Safe Environment Education sessions are not appropriate for those under the age of 18 and still in high school. Please do not bring your underage children unless the location specifies that child care is provided.
