A claimant can file:

Online at <u>childtaxrebate.wi.gov</u>. Available 24 hours per day/7 days per week, this method is the fastest and most convenient way to claim the rebate. A person can use a computer, tablet or smart phone.

By phone using 608-266-KIDS (5437). Available Monday – Friday, 7:45 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., a customer service representative will file a rebate claim on a claimant's behalf. This option is available for persons who do not have access to the internet or have trouble using our online application. There may be significant wait times for a representative.

When can a claimant apply for the Child Sales Tax Rebate?

A claimant can apply for the rebate May 15, 2018, through July 2, 2018. Late claims will not be accepted. What information does a claimant need to know before using the online application? The claimant should know:

Claimant's:

- Social Security number
- Wisconsin residency for calendar year 2017
- If married, your spouse's Social Security number (if you do not know this information, this data is optional)

Qualified child's:

- Legal name
- Social Security number
- Date of birth
- Wisconsin residency on December 31, 2017
- United States citizenship
