Liturgy Team

The Liturgy Team contributes to the worship of God in the Holy Mass and other liturgical celebrations of the SMSA community. They help create a reverent and prayerful atmosphere through their liturgical roles.

Expectations:

Applicants for any of the roles listed below are expected to attend the Liturgy Team training on August 15th, 2018 in the SMSA Chapel. Specific times for each role are as follows:

9:00am - Noon // Liturgy Core Team

9:00am - 10:30am // Altar Servers & Sacristans

10:30am - 11:00am // Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion

11:00am - 11:30am // Readers

11:30am - Noon // Hospitality Ministers

Altar Server*

- Assists the Priest at Holy Mass
- Open to grades 6-12

Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion**

- Assists with the distribution of Holy Communion
- Open to Grade 12

Hospitality Minister

- Directs students to their seats, greets guests, and encourages reverence during the liturgy.
- Open to Grades 9-12

Liturgy Core Team

- Helps with planning, coordination, and set-up for school liturgies
- Meets regularly with the Director of Campus Ministry
- Open to Grades 9-12

Reader*

- Proclaims the Word of God at Holy Mass
- Open to Grades 6-12

Sacristan*

- Prepares sanctuary and sacred vessels for Holy Mass.
- Open to Grades 11-12

Peer Ministry Team

The Peer Ministry Team helps members of the SMSA student body grow in their relationship with God. They help lead retreats and prayer services, plan events for Catholic Schools Week, and promote Campus Ministry activities across the SMSA campus.

Expectations:

Applicants for any of the roles listed below are required to attend the Peer Ministry Team training on **August 9th, 2018 from 11:30am – 2:00pm (lunch provided) in the SMSA Chapel/Campus Ministry** and regular meetings throughout the school year.

Peer Ministry Team

- Helps set the direction for Campus Ministry at SMSA and promote Campus Ministry events
- Meets regularly with the Director of Campus Ministry
- Helps plan and lead the 9th grade retreat to be held on September 7, 2018
- Helps plan and lead the 10th grade retreat to be held on March 13, 2019
- Open to Grades 11-12

Sacred Music

Sacred Music (formerly Music Liturgy) helps the SMSA community worship God with beautiful, sacred music. They help lead music for Holy Mass and other liturgical celebrations. Sacred Music is a collaboration between Campus Ministry and the Music Department.

Expectations:

Applicants for any of the roles listed below will be required to attend regular practices. **First meeting and practice schedule TBD.**

Liturgical Choir

- Leads congregation in singing for liturgies
- Open to grades 6-12

Liturgical Musicians

- Provide instrumental accompaniment for liturgies
- Open to Grades 6-12

Sacred Music Core Team

- Works with the Director of Campus Ministry and the Music Department to plan music for liturgies
- Open to Grades 9-12



Servant Leadership

As a Catholic Christian school, SMSA challenges students to imitate the sacrificial love of Jesus Christ, who suffered and died "as expiation for our sins" (1 John 4:10). The virtue of Christian charity, like all virtues, requires practice to bring it to perfection. With this in mind, SMSA students are required to perform service so as to strengthen this habit of charity in their lives.

Servant Leadership Core Team

- Works with the Director of Campus Ministry and other faculty members to plan, coordinate, and promote high school and system-wide service events based on the corporal works of mercy.
- Open to all students in grades 9-12.
- Core Team members will be required to meet regularly throughout the school year.
