



## Early College Credit Program (ECCP) Application Process

Early College Credit Forms must be completed each semester

All high school students taking courses at any of the three UW Oshkosh campuses for college credit are required to submit the following paperwork:

- 1. UW System Admissions Application (apply.wisconsin.edu)
  - -Submit once per year
  - -Select High School Special/ Early College Credit Program
- 2. Approved Early College Credit Program Form from high school -Submit each semester
- 3. High school transcripts
- 4. If Applicable: AP test scores, college transcript or placement test scores to verify pre-requisites have been met
