Free assistance completing the FAFSA at 40+ Wisconsin locations

## The following is needed to complete the FAFSA:

- Social Security Number/Alien Registration Card/Permanent Resident Card
- 2018 federal tax return and W2s
- 2018 untaxed income records, such as child support or veteran's non-education benefits (if applicable)
- Information on savings, investments, business assets and farm assets (if applicable)
- Cell phone (if you have one)
- Parent(s)' dates of birth
- Month and year of parents' marriage, divorce or separation
- Month and year of parents' marriage, divorce or separation
- FSA ID (if you have one). Visit fsaid.ed.gov to create an FSA ID. For assistance with the process, call 1-800-433-3243.

  - Every student and at least one parent of a dependent student will use the FSA ID.
  - Every student and at least one parent of a dependent student will use the FSA ID.
  - If a parent already has an FSA ID or has more than one child attending college, the parent will use the FSA ID.
  - Each child must have his or her own FSA ID.
  - Each FSA ID user must have a unique mobile phone number and/or email address.

It is highly recommended that a dependent student attends the event with parent/guardian so the FAFSA can be submitted that evening.
