

Hockey Games Hosted at Blue Line Family Ice Center Winter 2020-2021 - COVID Protocols

If you are feeling ill-- PLEASE STAY HOME.

Masks & Social Distancing

Masks are required. No exceptions. Social distancing will also be expected.

Team Drop-Off

Visiting Teams should be dropped off at the alternative EAST entrance of Blue Line.

Locker Room

Visiting teams will be shown their locker room, which can be used for changing, bag storage and bathroom usage. Showers will NOT be available. The locker room can be used for pregame and between periods. Masks are to be worn in the locker room at all times.

Concession stand

There will be no concessions this year.

Visiting Team Fans

Each visiting team athlete, coach and manager will be allowed 2 guests (Rink A) and 1 guest (Rink B). The visiting fans will sit on the SOUTH side of rink (Rink A) and NORTH side of bleachers (Rink B). No admission will be charged, however, donations accepted and fans will need to check in by giving their name and associated player name.

Visiting Players

Visiting players should sit on the SOUTH side (Rink A) while other levels are playing (Ex. Varsity can sit there while JV is playing). However, only those playing are allowed in Rink B.

Home Team Fans

Each home team athlete, coach and manager will be allowed 2 guests (Rink A & B). The home fans will sit on the NORTH side of rink (Rink A) and SOUTH side of bleachers (Rink B). No admission will be charged, however, donations accepted and fans will need to check in by giving their name and associated player name.

Doors Open

The doors will open 15 minutes prior to the first game of the evening. The doors will be open for the 2nd game of the evening as soon as the rink has been cleared. Please wait in your vehicles, if possible, to avoid congregation in the lobby. The rink will be emptied after each game.
