Spectators - Statement

With the COVID-19 numbers consistently trending upwards, the Flyway Conference schools have decided to implement a new admittance policy to games for the Winter sports season.

Each player will be given the opportunity to have **2** spectators (whose names MUST be provided prior to the game) for home/away conference activities. The maximum amount that a family can receive, regardless of gender or activity level (MS, JV2, JV, & Varsity) will be 2. The home school will check spectators off with a roster at the door.

Event workers, coaching staff and managers will not need a pass to be admitted into the event but should be include on a list supplied to the school.

- No additional passes will be handed out.

Pre-Game Expectations

Community/Spectators

Pre-screen for symptoms before leaving your home. If not feeling well PLEASE stay home.

Masks are required at all times - No mask, no entry

Sanitize upon entrance

No concessions will be offered

Follow movement routes to seating area

Find seating in designated areas

If sitting in general population area, sit as a family

During Game Expectations

Masks stay on

Leave your seat only in an emergency limited access

If you get up, follow the travel route

Post Game Expectations

Community will be dismissed in an orderly fashion to avoid mass congregation

Leave immediately upon dismissal - no pictures or congregations will be allowed on playing surface or in the school building

Sanitize before leaving

If transporting an athlete home after event you must exit the building and wait in vehicle for them. No congregating outside the doors.

Once you leave, no re-entry will be allowed

Masks can be removed upon departure

Athletes and Masks

Visiting Team Travel/Drop-Off

- Before leaving, please review all Flyway expectations with staff and players.
- Pre-screen all individuals being transported prior to departure.
- Wait at your drop-off location for a school representative for further direction.

Locker Rooms and Changing

- At this time, teams are **EXPECTED** to come prepared in their gear.
- Visiting teams will NOT have access to a locker room. Individual schools may make exceptions.
- If bathrooms are needed by the visiting team, please use the designated event bathrooms.

Ball Rack • The Home School WILL provide a separate basketball rack for each program for warm-ups.

Table Workers

- Table workers must sanitize their area at each game's half-time and end.
- Must provide hand sanitizer and rags/spray for sanitizing the ball.



Officials

- You will **NOT** be granted a locker room at this time, so please come prepared.
- Masks are required for officials at this time during the contests and electronic whistles will be provided by the school if needed.

Basketball Specific Game Procedures - WIAA

• Pre-game:

- Ball given to officials and sanitized as recommended by the ball manufacturer and not used for warm- ups.
- The host school should ensure that the ball is sanitized during time-outs and between halves.
- Pre- and Post-Game Ceremony
 - Suspend the pre-game introduction handshakes.
 - Suspend post-game protocol of shaking hands.

Basketball Specific Game Procedures - WIAA

• During Game:

- Official may stand 6 feet or greater away from player making the throw-in and bounce the ball to that player on a front court throw-in.
- Extended timeouts may be granted for sanitization purposes.

Jump Ball

- Eliminate the jump ball and award the ball to the visiting team the first alternating possession for the throw in.
- To start an overtime period, use a coin toss to determine which team is awarded the ball.
