Applicant:	Students in Fond du Lac County, 13 thru 19 years of age, with a belief in the right to life from conception to natural death.
Cash Prize:	<u>1st place: \$300</u> <u>2nd place: \$200</u> <u>3rd place: \$100</u>
Cover page:	On this page include ONLY - your name, age, home address, email address, phone number, school and grade level so it can be removed for unbiased judging .
Title page:	A separate essay title page using graphics and imagination - for additional points.
Requirements:	Requirements: 600 word - typed essay, double-spaced. No deductions if a few words over or under. List sources of references, quotes and research data.
Торіс:	Persuasive essay that supports your pro-life belief. Subject may be on any right-to-life issue (abortion, euthanasia, assisted suicide, embryonic stem cell research). Why is this issue important to you? Include a paragraph stating what you have done or would like to do to raise awareness and to promote the pro-life cause.
Judging criteria:	Content (substantive information or creative material) Composition (combining parts to form a whole) Grammar (spelling, structure of sentences) Appearance (title page design, following entry rules) References and research (variety of sources and quotes identified) Personal Experience
Judges:	Three Fond du Lac Chapter members who will NOT know the identity of the entries.
DEADLINE:	Essay must be submitted no later than December 1, 2021
