August 23 - Grades P3 - Gr. 5 School Supply Drop Off (10:00am - 6:00pm)

- Elementary class rosters will be posted outside the front office. Students will have the opportunity to visit their classroom to meet their teacher, drop off school supplies, get lunch accounts set up, pick up bus tags for their backpacks and more. Please enter through the South Hall entrance.
- The eight hour window of time will offer the opportunity for traffic and to be spread out throughout the day and ample time to start building a relationship with your child's teacher.

August 23 - Grades 6-8 common instructions for a successful orientation day

- Parents may drop off and pick up their students by the South Hall entrance in the upper parking lot.
- Students should plan to dress in SMSA spirit wear on top with appropriate shorts or jeans.
- All 6th - 8th grade students need to plan on bringing their school supplies to organize in their lockers.

August 23 - 6th Grade Welcome to Middle School (7:45am - 11:00am)

- Students will start building relationships with faculty and staff, learn locker combinations, experience passing time, learn about how MS lunch varies from elementary lunch, and get the opportunity to prepare for Middle School at SMSA.
- Students will drop their supplies off by the gathering/art display area as you enter the Middle School wing. The space is right outside Mrs. Rodenkirch's art classroom.

August 23 - 8th Grade Leadership (7:45am - 11:00am)

- Students will begin/continue building relationships with faculty and staff, get the opportunity to pray and play together and be engaged in presentations on being student leaders for the Elementary school by living the Ledger Way.
- Students will begin their day by meeting the teachers on the second floor by the 8th grade homeroom teachers: Mrs. Holz, Mrs. Anderson and Mr. McGalloway.

August 23 - 7th Grade Unity (11:45 - 3:00)

- Students will begin building relationships with faculty and staff, and have a chance to pray and play together, and get the opportunity to bond as a class.
- Students will begin their day by meeting their teachers on the second floor by the seventh grade homeroom teachers: Mrs. Abler, Mrs. Mammal and Mrs. Dahlinger.

HIGH SCHOOL, Grades 9-12

Tuesday, August 23: Orientation Day and Supply Drop-Off

Freshmen Orientation:

- Student Drop-Off: 7:45 am enter at North Hall. Students will receive homeroom assignments upon arrival and proceed to their assigned homerooms by 8am, where attendance will be taken.
- Students should come dressed in SMSA uniform attire.
- Students will receive locker assignments.
- Students will meet their homeroom teacher and administration, pray together, learn about the academic life and student life expectations of *The Ledger Way*. Orientation aims to give freshmen a positive start as they transition from middle school to high school.
- All freshmen should plan to drop-off their school supplies on this day. Student Pick-Up: 10:00 am exit from North Hall

→ ***Juniors*** 12:30 pm - 2:00 pm

- All students should plan to be prompt, enter school through North Hall. All students will receive homeroom assignments upon arrival and proceed to homerooms where attendance will be taken.
- Students should come dressed in SMSA uniform attire.
- Students will spend time in Homeroom to receive important reminders and updates pertinent to the start of school; take time to prepare their lockers; pray together; and receive an overview of the updated student and family handbook.
- Students will receive locker assignments.
- All students should plan to drop-off their school supplies on this day.

Tuesday, August 23rd: Class of 2023 College Application Night

2022-2023 Daily "Bell" Schedule for High School

Modified BLOCK - *Rotation of A & B Day classes follow the same bell schedule*

BLOCK TIMES	PERIODS	NOTES
7:30 - 8:15	ZERO HOUR*	45 Minute Period. Zero Hour occurs on BOTH A & B Days Monday -Thursday (not Fridays).
8:20 - 9:50	A1 & B5	90 Minute Class Period. Attendance & Instruction. Time added for Prayer & Pledge of Allegiance.
9:55 - 11:20	A2 & B6	85 Minute Class Period. Attendance & Instruction
11:25 - 12:50	A3 & B7	85 Minute Class Period. Attendance & Instruction
12:55 - 1:10	HOMEROOM	15 Minute Period. Attendance. PA announcements; meal prayer; staggered release (by class) to lunch
1:10 - 1:35	LUNCH & Activity Time	25 Minute Period. All high school students are scheduled for a common LUNCH period together in Korbie Commons. Clubs and organizations may schedule "Lunch meetings" with moderators. A scheduled rotation of Lunch meetings will be shared. Students may bring their lunch to club meetings.
1:45 - 3:15	A4 & B8	90 Minute Class Period. Attendance & Instruction. Time added for end of the day PA announcements.

* **Notes for 7:30-8:15am (ZERO HOUR):**

- Students not enrolled in Zero Hour courses may report to school by 8:15am. Students without Zero Hour classes who arrive on campus early may wait in Korbie Commons for classes to begin.
- Limited breakfast service will be available during this time.
- Teachers, administration and pupil services staff are available to support students during this time for tutoring, planning, reviews etc. Students may make appointments to meet with teachers, or walk-in. Teachers may make appointments to meet with students.
- On Fridays, Mass in the Chapel is a weekly option reserved especially for high school students, faculty and staff. On Mondays, Reconciliation is available in the Chapel.
