EMPOWERING, PROTECTING OUR YOUTH

No one knows more about what's going on at school than students themselves. Now when Wisconsin youth think there's a threat to themselves, their classmates or their school, they have a single, statewide resource to voice their concerns – with complete confidentiality – and they can trust that adults are ready to respond to the threat.

A SINGLE, STATEWIDE RESOURCE

Speak Up, Speak Out is a Resource Center created by the Wisconsin Department of Justice (DOJ) Office of School Safety to provide communities with a centralized safety tool, available at no cost to schools. Resource center staff are available 24/7 to respond to school safety concerns from students, as well as parents, school staff or community members.

Speak Up, Speak Out is a one-stop resource for:

- Threat reporting system
- Threat assessment consultation
- Critical incident response
- General school safety guidance

SAFETY THREAT? TIME FOR ACTION.

A single tip can avert disaster. It's vital to report threats, behaviors and actions before at-risk individuals hurt themselves or others – for example:

- Assaults or abuse (physical / verbal)
- Bullying
- Threats / Planned attacks
- Preoccupation with violence, or groups that advocate it
- Preoccupation with weapons
- Depression, withdrawal, talk of suicide
- Intense anger, resentment, or loss of control
- Substance abuse
- Any 'red flags' that cause you concern
