

Drug Drop Box Guidelines

Safely dispose of unused and expired medications

Accepted

- Prescription and over the counter:
 - Pills
 - Creams/Ointments
 - Liquids medications (in original container)
 - Powders
 - Inhalers
 - Pet Medications

Not Accepted

- Sharps (needles, syringes, lancets, etc.)
- Hazardous or chemical waste
- Mercury thermometers
- Electronic glucose monitors
- Non-medical inhalers
- Commercial, business, or long-term care deposits
- E-cigarettes/vape pens with batteries
- Aerosol cans

Directions for Safe Disposal



1. **Empty** all pills from container & place them into a zip-top bag.

Liquid medication should remain in bottles up to 3 oz.



2. **Recycle** empty pill bottles that are 3" x 3" or larger.

Discard all plastic caps and small pill bottles.



3. **Drop off** all unused prescriptions at designated locations throughout the county.
