Lev Werdin is one year old and was born with Down Syndrome, heart defects, epilepsy, Becker's muscle dystrophy, severe sleep apnea, lung disease, and severe pulmonary hypertension. Lev has been battling severe pulmonary hypertension in the ICU since January of this year.

Currently, Lev is very ill and remains in the ICU. He's intubated and medically paralyzed, fighting for his life.

The Werdin family is so grateful that God gave them Lev. He's one of their biggest blessings!
